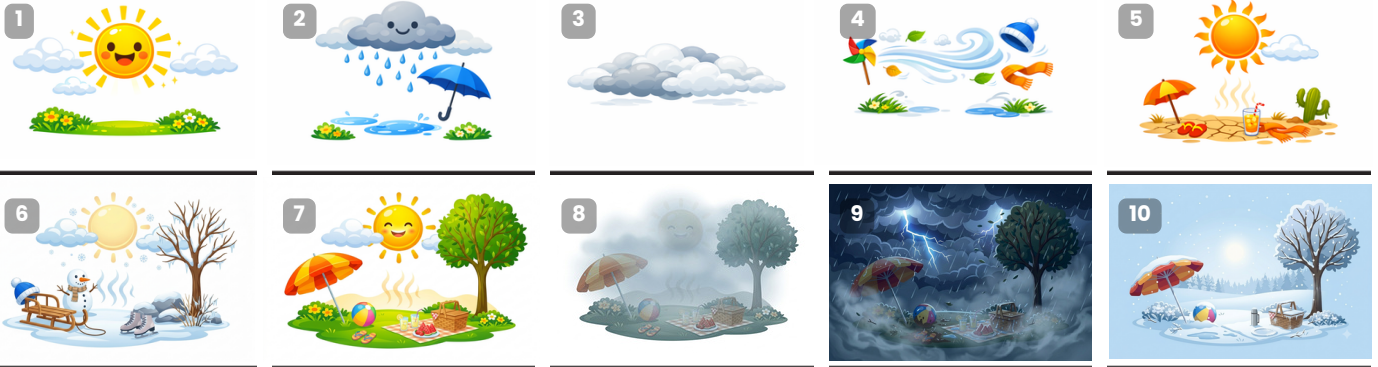

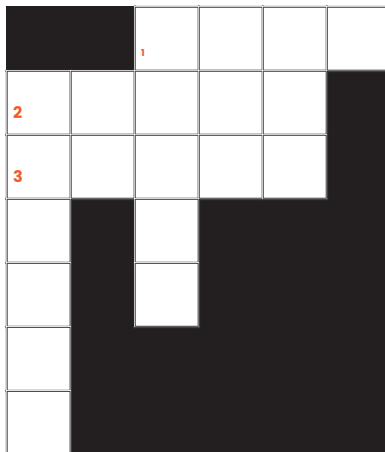

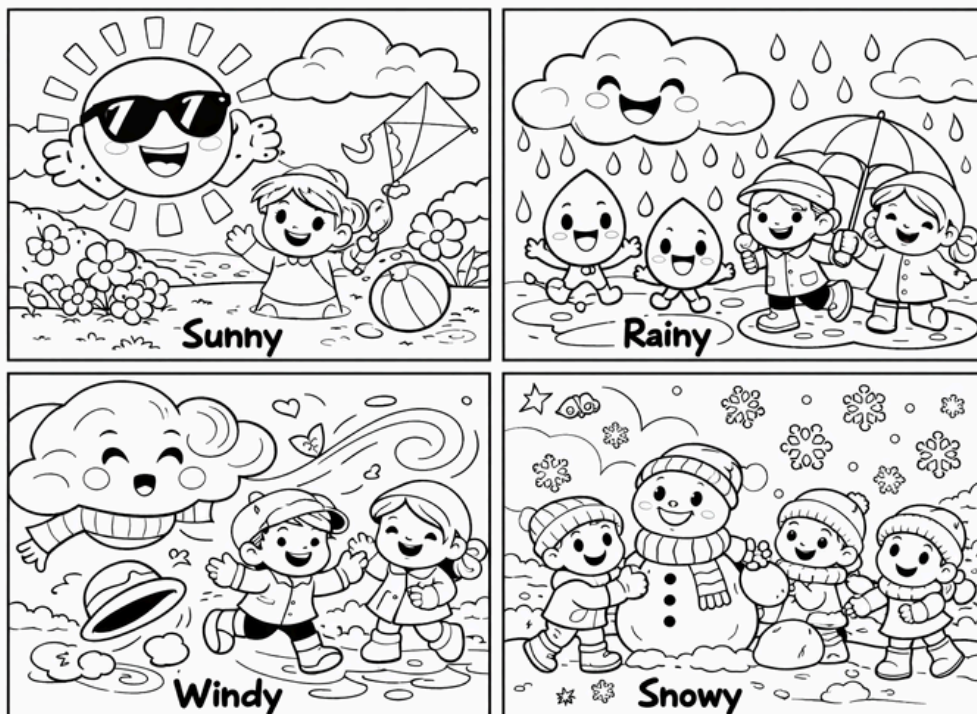

**7 grammar: it's + adjective**

Use "It's" to talk about the weather.

It's + Adjective

We use **"It's"** (It is) with an adjective to talk about the weather. We do not say "I am hot" for weather — we say **"It's hot."**

Structure	Example
It's + hot	It's hot.
It's + cold	It's cold.
It's + sunny	It's sunny.
It's + rainy	It's rainy.
It's + cloudy	It's cloudy.
It's + windy	It's windy.

① **Remember:** "It's" = "It is". We always use "it" for weather, never "I" or "you". Example: ☒ "It's sunny." ☐ "I'm sunny."

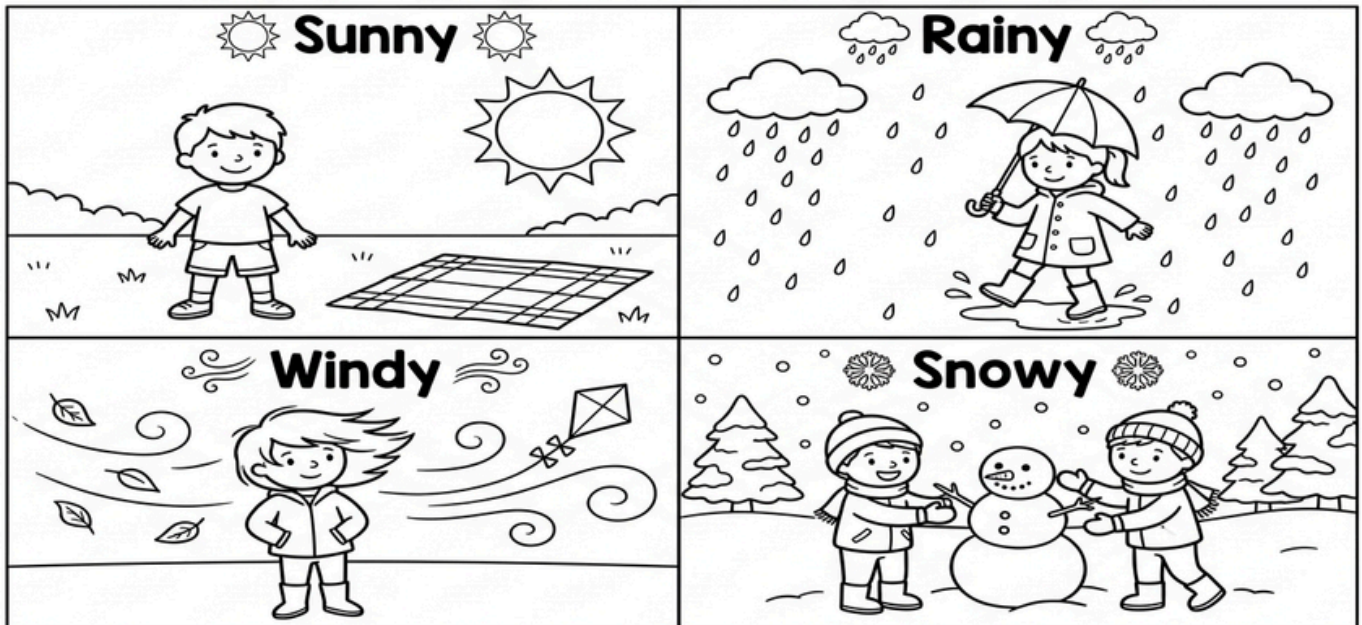
